NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Limited Tax General Obligation Note, 2017B-2 (Private Activity – AMT)
July 9, 2019

The Port Commission of the Port of Everett, Washington (the “Port”) will hold an open public hearing on July 9, 2019, at 4:00 pm, or as soon thereafter as possible, during the meeting of the Port Commission at the offices of the Port in the Blue Heron Room at 1205 Craftsman Way, Everett, Washington, for the purpose of considering the borrowing of up to \$35,000,000 under the terms of a Limited Tax General Obligation Note, 2017B-2 (Private Activity – AMT) (the “Note”) evidencing a line of credit. The proceeds of drawings may be used for multiple purposes. In addition, a drawing under the Note may be used to provide funds for the acquisition of up to 67 acres of the vacant former Kimberly-Clark mill site situated at 2600 Federal Avenue in the City of Everett, for the following possible uses: (i) stormwater/discharge water storage facilities, (ii) tideland improvements, (iii) roadways within the site, (iv) shipyard maintenance facilities, (v) warehousing, (vi) cargo facilities, and (vii) cold storage facilities.

Comments will be taken from all members of the public attending the hearing. Written comments may be sent prior to the meeting to Eric Russell, Chief Finance Officer of the Port of Everett, P.O. Box 538, Everett, WA 98206.
