The Port of Everett is pleased to announce an all-new, exciting free program available to your fourth grade class! Through a partnership with the award-winning Imagine Children's Museum, your students will participate in a program which helps them understand the important role the Port of Everett plays in our local, regional and global economy.

Using a highly interactive game, a Museum Educator will guide students through situations and activities that will help them gain an understanding of how ports operate, how they are governed and the important role they play in the economic growth of our local community and beyond. Students will also learn about the Port of Everett's role in environmental stewardship and sustainability.

This program aligns with fourth grade Social Studies Grade Level Expectations (GLEs) for Washington State. The program emphasizes topics in civics, economics and geography in a way that fosters communication and discussion. The Museum Educator will be in your classroom for approximately 60-90 minutes, but will also be available for follow-up questions via email.

In order to take advantage of this program, here are a few things you should know:

- The program will be presented in consecutive class times to all fourth grade classes in your school on the same day. Teachers should coordinate to choose a day which will work for all classes.
- Because the program is grant funded, there are a **limited number** of presentations available. Reservations will be taken on a first come, first served basis.
- The program is not only engaging for your students, but teachers also have a very special role in the game!
